BYLAWS UPDATE

At the July 28, 2022 Board of Directors meeting, In accordance with Article XVII, Section 1, of the Mustang Chamber of Commerce Bylaws, a motion was made, seconded, and approved to add the following section regarding Directors Emeritus:

ARTICLE VIII – DIRECTORS EMERITUS



*Section 1. The Board may appoint one or more **Directors Emeritus** as it shall from time to time determine. Each director emeritus appointed shall hold office at the pleasure of the Board. A director emeritus shall be entitled, but shall have no obligation, to attend and be present at the meetings of the Board, although a meeting of the Board may be held without notice to any director emeritus and no director emeritus shall be considered in determining whether a quorum of the Board is present. A director emeritus shall advise and counsel the Board on the business and operations of the Company as requested by the Board; however, a director emeritus shall not be entitled to vote on any matter presented to the Board. Unless otherwise determined by the Board of Directors, the election of a Director Emeritus shall be for up to a one year term and be potentially renewed annually at the Board Retreat in June. In order that the position may be solely an honorary one carrying with it no obligation for the performance of any specific duties, the provisions pertaining to Directors contained in the Articles of Incorporation of the Corporation and in these Bylaws shall not apply to any Director Emeritus. Directors Emeritus shall not be entitled to receive any compensation from the Chamber for serving in such capacity.*

*Section 2. **Eligibility.** In order to be considered for designation as a board member emeritus, a person must be a former member of the organization's board of directors who has:*

- served the organization's board of directors with distinction;*
- held an important leadership role and made significant contributions;*
- engaged in major volunteer or advocacy activities in his or her service on the board;*
- completed the term(s) for which he or she was appointed;*
- Participated in one or more of the organization's activities (e.g., events, volunteerism, fundraising, government relations, networking, etc.)*

*Section 3. **Election.** Annually, with the recommendation of the Executive Committee. The Executive Committee will present the nomination(s) along with supporting statements to the organization's board of directors for its consideration. A simple majority vote of directors at a meeting at which a quorum is present is sufficient to approve an appointment.*

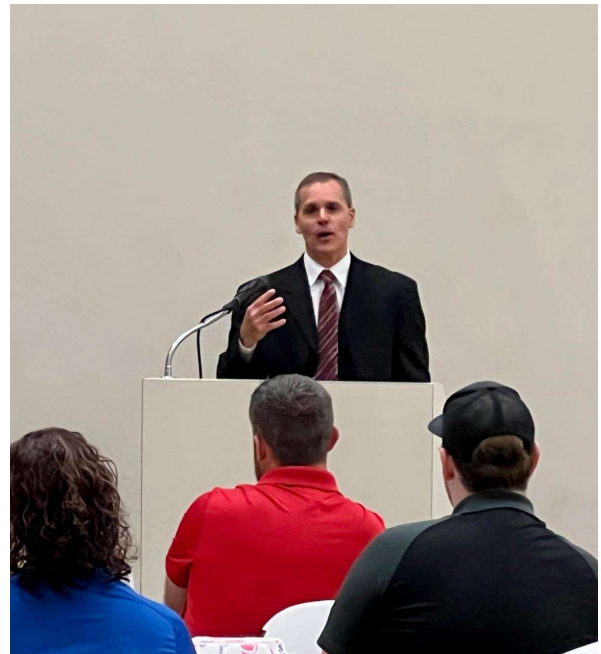
