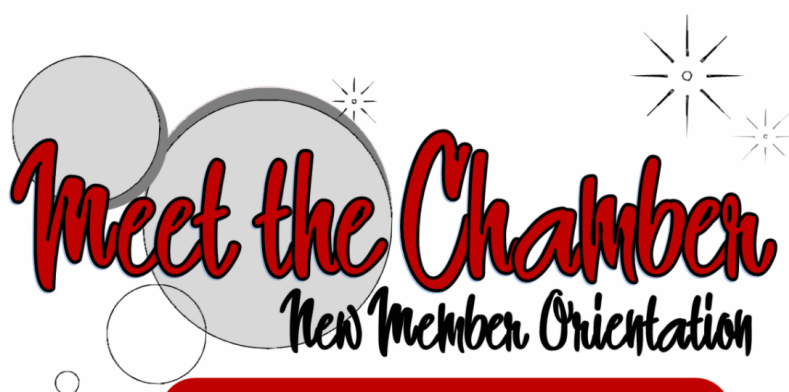

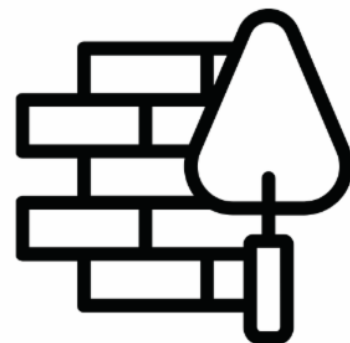

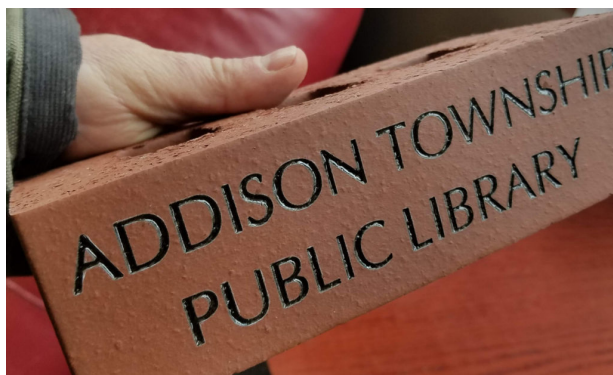
## MORTAR BRICK CAMPAIGN
